## Monthly Tuition Payments



Our tuition is a yearly tuition that is divided into nine equal payments (September-May). Tuition is normally due by the 10th of each month. The one-time supply fee is also due by Sept. 10. Preschool accepts cash, checks, or money orders.

## Faith At Home: Starting Preschool



Going off to Preschool or Kindergarten or First Grade for the first time is an exciting milestone for children and their families. As children prepare to venture out from home and begin a new routine at school, they need to hear Jesus' promise to be with them always.

### Activity Plan

Say this prayer aloud to begin:

Dear God, we thank you for (child's name). Soon she will start going to school! Be with us as we hear from the Bible how much Jesus loves (child's name). Amen.

- Have your child sit in your lap or right next to you. Read Mark 10:13-16.
- After reading the story, hand gestures and tell this simple version of the story while acting it out.

People were bringing their children to Jesus (move your arms like you're running).

The disciples said: STOP! (put your hand out, palm forward).

Jesus said, "Let the children come to me" (motion with your hand moving toward you).

Jesus picked up the children, hugged them, put his hands on their heads, and blessed them.

(Give your child a big hug.)

- Tell your child that Jesus loves her just like he loved the children in the Bible story. He sends his love to her through the hugs that Mom, Dad, and other loved ones give her. On the first day of school, family members or other loved ones will give her a big hug before she gets on the bus or goes into her classroom. Jesus' love is in those hugs, too.
- Point out his school bag or backpack. Your child will take Jesus' love with him, just like he takes his bag or backpack, as he begins each new school day.
- Give your child a blessing. Have each member of the family take turns putting their hands on the child's head, as Jesus did in the Bible story. Say the blessing, "Remember, Jesus is with you wherever you go. Jesus loves you and so do I."
- Finish with a prayer:

Dear God, be with (child's name) on his first day of school. Be with his teacher (teacher's name) and his friends. Give them all a great start to their school year together. Help (child's name) to remember that Jesus loves him and to share that love with others wherever he goes. Amen.
