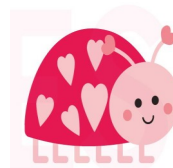

Needed: Bible, Red, pink, and/or white construction paper or cardstock, markers, crayons or colored pencils, scissors, heart stickers (optional)



- Using the paper or cardstock, cut seven hearts of different sizes per family member. (Parents may need to cut these for small children.)
- On one side of the hearts write TO: [family member's name] LOVE: [your name]. Optional: Place heart stickers on this side.
- On the other side of the hearts write (or draw) one of the following:
 * A verse about loving God or God's love for us. (Parents may need to help younger or non-reading children find these verses. For children

who can't write, have them draw pictures of what the verse means to them. Parents can also re-word a verse, if needed, so a child can understand it.)
