Needed: Bible, Red, pink, and/or white construction paper or cardstock, markers, crayons or colored pencils, scissors, heart stickers (optional)

1. Using the paper or cardstock, cut seven hearts of different sizes per family member. (Parents may need to cut these for small children.)

2. On one side of the hearts write TO: [family member's name] LOVE: [your name]. Optional: Place heart stickers on this side.

3. On the other side of the hearts write (or draw) one of the following:

* A verse about loving God or God's love for us. (Parents may need to help younger or non-reading children find these verses. For children who can't write, have them draw pictures of

what the verse means to them. Parents can also re-word a verse, if needed, so a child can understand it.)
